1. This letter is furnished to you by the Municipal Court, City of Colorado City, Texas, to assist you in making disposition of the charge(s) filed against you. PLEASE NOTE: The Judge cannot discuss the merits of pending judicial proceedings prior to trial. **IF YOU FAIL TO RESPOND TO THE CHARGE(S) BY THE APPEARANCE DATE SHOWN ON THE CITATION, AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE MAY BE FILED AGAINST YOU FOR VIOLATION OF A PROMISE TO APPEAR AND WARRANTS WILL BE ISSUED FOR YOUR ARREST. A JUVENILE THAT FAILS TO APPEAR BY THE TIME AND DATE ON THE CITATION MAY HAVE THEIR LICENSE SUSPENDED. A WARRANT FEE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR PROCESSING OR EXECUTING A WARRANT.**
2. IF YOU WISH TO ENTER A PLEA OF GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE, please so indicate in the proper space provided on the reply form on the reverse side. A plea of Nolo Contendere means that you do not contest the state's charge(s) against you. The fine for a Nolo Contendere plea is the same as that for a plea of Guilty. Either plea indicates that you agree to waive appearance before the Court for trial. Please refer to the fine schedule shown below to determine the total amount of the fine(s) acceptable by the Court. Make your remittance by Money Order or Cashier's Check payable to the Court Clerk, City of Colorado City, Texas. RETURN YOUR COPY OF THE CITATION WITH THIS LETTER AND YOUR REMITTANCE TO ASSURE PROPER CREDIT.
3. IF YOU WISH TO ENTER A PLEA OF NOT GUILTY and desire a trial before the Judge or before a jury, you MUST (unless an attorney files a Notice of Appearance) appear in person on your appearance date. If you so request, you have the right to trial by jury.
4. DRIVER'S SAFETY COURSE INFORMATION: Under the laws of the State of Texas, you may be able to have this (one) charge be dismissed by taking a driving safety course. HOWEVER, YOU WILL LOSE THAT RIGHT IF YOU DO NOT PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE COURT OF YOUR DESIRE TO DO SO AND PAY ALL FEES ON OR BEFORE YOUR APPEARANCE DATE (AS SHOWN ON YOUR CITATION). You cannot have a speeding citation dismissed if it is a violation of 25MPH or more above the posted speed limit, you are ineligible if you have completed a Driver's Safety Course under this option within the year immediately preceding the date of the citation, you must have had a valid Texas Driver's License or permit and show proof of financial responsibility at the time of the citation as required by Section 601.081. If the alleged act was committed while operating a motorcycle, a motorcycle operator training course may be taken as approved by the DPS. If you wish to use this option to have this (one) charge dismissed, read and complete the request form on the reverse side and return it to the Court with the required fee and proof of insurance on or before your appearance date. You will have 90 days from the date the court grants permission for the course to complete and provide the Court with the required documentation showing successful completion of an approved Driving Safety Course. IF YOU MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AS STATED ON THE D.S.C. REQUEST FORM ON THE REVERSE SIDE, THEN YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETING THE COURSE AND REMITTING THE COMPLETION CERTIFICATE TO THE COURT. (FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS ON THE REVERSE SIDE.)
5. Be Advised: If you fail to appear in court, as provided by law, for the presentation of the offense, your Driver's License may be denied at renewal. A fee may also be added for each offense submitted to the Department of Public Safety.
6. **TRAFFIC OFFENSES: JUVENILES 16 & UNDER MUST APPEAR IN COURT WITH PARENT OR GUARDIAN.**
7. **ALCOHOL OFFENSES AGE 17-20 MUST APPEAR IN COURT TO MAKE A PLEA. JUVENILES 16 & UNDER MUST APPEAR IN COURT WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO MAKE A PLEA.**
8. **ALL JUVENILES AND THEIR PARENTS HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE THE COURT (IN WRITING) WITH THE CURRENT ADDRESS OF THE CHILD. FAILURE TO DO SO IS A CLASS C MISDEMEANOR AND CAN RESULT IN THE ARREST OF THE PARENT AND CHILD. THE OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE ADDRESS TERMINATES ON DISCHARGE AND SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT OR FINAL DISPOSITION NOT REQUIRING A FINDING OF GUILT.**
